

MyFreeTaxes.com - Learn More About Filing a Free Tax Return

For the 2017 MyFreeTaxes season, if you are a filing a simple return, and have an Adjusted Gross Income (AGI) up to \$64,000 per tax return, you are invited to file your state and federal returns, for free, by using this MyFreeTaxes link:

Please note that ONAC is not in a position to answer any of your tax filing questions, address MyFreeTaxes IT questions, or to prepare your returns for you. If you have questions while you are preparing your returns on the MyFreeTaxes site, or if you are asked for payment information to prepare your federal or state tax returns and your income is \$64,000 or less, please call this toll free number: 1-855-698-9435.

To file your taxes on MyFreeTaxes.com, you will need the following:

- Social Security or Individual Taxpayer Identification Number (ITIN) for each family member and working adult.
- 1095-A if you received a tax credit from the healthcare.gov marketplace.
- Childcare provider name, address and tax ID, if applicable.
- Bank routing and account numbers for checking or savings account (if you qualify for refund via secure direct deposit).
- Last year's tax return, if you have it.
- A valid email address.

For those wishing to go to file in person at a Voluntary Income Tax Assistance (VITA) site, you may search for sites near you at www.myfreetaxes.com.

Please note: If you, or someone you know, have less than \$47,955 (\$53,505 if married filing jointly) in adjusted gross income, you may be eligible to claim the Earned Income Tax Credit (EITC).
